A plastic bag needs 450 years to deteriorate. So it is better to use reusable bags. 14

By limiting your speed to 120 per hour driving instead of 130 you can reduce you oil consumption of 2 litres per hour driving. This is a good saving!! 15

80% of the French motorists drive alone in a car. The car pooling allows saving money by sharing the price of the trip, it saves time by reducing the traffic jams and it improves the air quality by limiting the pollution. 16

False! When we buy a good we also buy the work conditions from those who have produced it and the eventual environmental impact of the production process. With the globalisation, if we buy a product here, it is often produced in another place and the impact of this act is then not only local. 17

Reducing the house temperature of 1 degree allows to save7% on your energy bill. This isn't insignificant! 18

The green point shows that the producer contributes financially to the package collection and recycling. Attention! this symbol doesn't show always that the product is recyclable or recycled. 19

By choosing a cycle of 40 degrees, instead of 90 degrees you consume 3 times less energy. 20
